Oak Ridge Neighborhood Entrance Improvements

We have made some progress with the entry project. The Roseville Parks Department recently completed minor improvements including painting the rusted irrigation box and back filling areas along the base of the wall that had been repaired. They also accepted ownership of the landscaping at the entrance and along the wall on Cirby Way.

Unfortunately, the Roseville Department of Public Works informed us that the Cirby Way wall is owned by those who own parcels attached to it. The board wants to know if these homeowners are aware that they own the wall. If you own property along the wall or know someone who does, please let us know. We have sent out a couple of letters to the home owners where the wall has been repaired due to traffic accidents and are awaiting their reply. We would be interested to know who did the repairs. Per the Department of Public Works, it would have been the homeowner. If the city did the repair, that may be considered taking ownership.

The board has tried also to contact the owner who lives on the corner—an area with significant damage to the wall due to tree growth--without luck. Our goal is to have the wall repaired and mount a Cirby Ranch neighborhood sign on the wall.
